
Guidance Notes


Readings between 0-15% - readings not recorded because no cause for concern.

Readings between 15%-20% - require further investigation. Compare with the average reading. Consider asking to recheck the area in three months.

Readings above 20% - will identify areas possibly needing remedial work. There may be signs of water ingress or evidence of moisture. Again, it may be worth considering recheck after three months.

Readings above 30% - structural damage may be occurring and deterioration is
